SCIENCE MUSEUM PUBLIC HOURS TO CHANGE OCTOBER 5 Reduced admission rates offered October 5 – 30, 2009 during exhibit transition

BUFFALO, NY (September 25, 2009) – After the October 4 closing of *Gunther von Hagens' BODY WORLDS & The Story of the Heart*, the Buffalo Museum of Science's hours of operation will change to the following:

(Wednesday hours will extend to 6:00pm with the opening of GOOD VIBRATIONS on October 31)

During the museum's transition from *BODY WORLDS* to its fall themed experience, *GOOD VIBRATIONS*, some areas of the museum will be unavailable to visitors and therefore general admission will be discounted by \$2.

Reduced Admission Rates October 5 – 30, 2009

- \$5 Adults (*normally \$7*)
- \$4 Seniors 62+ (*normally \$6*)
- \$3 Children ages 3-18 and students with school ID (*normally \$5*)
- Free to Museum Members and children under 3

The museum will return to its normal admission rates on October 31 with the opening of *GOOD VIBRATIONS*.
