LAST CHANCE TO EXPERIENCE “GOOD VIBRATIONS”

Buffalo Museum of Science to offer reduced admission prices while preparing for
Sesame Street Presents: The Body

Buffalo, NY (January 15, 2010) – The Buffalo Museum of Science’s current themed experience, *GOOD VIBRATIONS*, has entered its final days and will close on Sunday, January 31.

GOOD VIBRATIONS examines the physics of sound through wave formation, pitch, amplification, and resonance. In addition to displaying music-related pieces from the museum’s collection and interactive sound stations from the Exploratorium in San Francisco, *GOOD VIBRATIONS* offers facilitated hands-on activities and a popular music video game as well as musical performances on Saturdays and Sundays.

The museum also teamed up with the Hard Rock Café, Niagara Falls, USA, to feature pieces from Hard Rock International’s world-famous memorabilia collection. The collaboration marks the first time the two organizations have ever partnered together. Given the name of the exhibit, one particular brown burst hollow-bodied guitar used by Carl Wilson of the Beach Boys was hand chosen by Hard Rock International’s team of memorabilia experts to loan to this exhibit.

The *GOOD VIBRATIONS* experience and activities are included with museum admission.
