## **ROBOTIC DINOSAURS RUN EXTENDED THROUGH COLUMBUS DAY HOLIDAY**

**Buffalo Museum of Science will be open to the public on Monday, October 11 from 10am to 4pm**

**BUFFALO, NY (October 1, 2010)** – The Buffalo Museum of Science will extend the run of it's travelling exhibit, *Robotic Dinosaurs*, through Monday, October 11 in order to provide families with a fun activity on their days off from work and school. This will be the final day for visitors to experience the exhibit before it closes.

Originally scheduled to close on October 10, *Robotic Dinosaurs* offers guests an up-close view of nine robotic dinosaurs including Tyrannosaurus Rex, Apatosaurus, Pachycephalosaurus, an adult Maiasaura with eggs and hatchlings, Stegosaurus and a Pteranodon. Visitors young and old can operate a hands-on control box to move the "skeleton" of a Duckbill or feel like true paleontologists at the fossil rub stations.



*Robotic Dinosaurs* is free for Museum Members or included with general museum admission: \$8 adults; \$7 seniors 62+; \$6 children 2-17, military and students with ID).

Museum visitors may also view a 3D film or two in the museum's new 3D Cinema. *SOS Planet 3D* plays at 12 and 2pm and *Dinosaurs 3D: Giants of Patagonia* plays at 11am, 1pm and 3pm. Films for non-members are \$3 each or \$5 for a double feature plus general museum admission and just \$2 each for Museum Members.

*Robotic Dinosaurs* has attracted over 40,000 guests since it opened on June 26. The museum's next travelling exhibit, *From Here To There*, is an interactive experience focusing on the science of locomotion and opens on October 23.
