LIMITED TICKETS STILL AVAILABLE FOR BEER TASTING FUNDRAISER AT BUFFALO MUSEUM OF SCIENCE

3rd annual Beerology event on April 9th benefits educational programming
at the museum and Tiff Nature Preserve

BUFFALO (February 7, 2011) – Tickets are selling fast for the 3rd annual Beerology event at the Buffalo Museum of Science (1020 Humboldt Pkwy., Buffalo) on Saturday, April 9 from 6 to 9pm. The event is for adults 21 and over.

This beer tasting fundraiser for the museum offers science “on tap” and features home brewing demonstrations and presentations by local “beerologists”. The beer talks, sponsored by Community Beer Works, will cover topics including the science of beer making and Buffalo’s historic brewing industry. Eleven brewing vendors participated in the 2010 event and BMS expects even more in 2011.

To date, eighteen beer vendors have registered to be on-site pouring samples of their brews throughout the entire museum, including:

Admission includes 10 drink tickets good for one 3-ounce beer tasting each. Additional drink tickets may be purchased starting at 7pm. Tickets also include a commemorative beer glass, appetizers from some of Buffalo’s best restaurants, live entertainment and access to the museum’s permanent museum exhibits and galleries.

Tickets are \$40 and can be purchased online at www.sciencebuff.org or at the museum’s admission desk during museum hours (Sun-Thurs 10am-4pm, Fri 10am-7pm). A \$5 discount is offered to museum members with a valid member I.D. number.
